Lambrini Kourkouta has been a Professor in the Nursing Department of the Alexandrion Technological Educational Institute (ATEI) of Thessaloniki since 1998. Since September 2013, she was also the President of the Department of the Alexandrian Technological Educational Institution of Thessaloniki (ATEI) until October 2015. From 2019 till now she is a Professor in the Nursing department of the International Hellenic University. In addition to her duties in the undergraduate curriculum, she also teaches in two postgraduate programs related to her field of expertise in the International Hellenic University and in the University of Thessaly.

She studied Nursing at the University of Athens (1989) and the Higher School of Nursing at Evangelismos Hospital (1985). She holds a Master's Degree in Research Methodology and the History of Medicine and her Doctoral Thesis is reported in "History of Nursing in Byzantium" (1993). She has also attended many Continuing Education Nursing and Health Seminars (over 150).

She has extensive clinical experience as having worked as a nurse and head nurse in 'Evangelismos' General Hospital. She has taught many courses in the Nursing Department of Faculty of Health and Caring Professions of the Alexandrian Technological Educational Institution of Thessaloniki (ATEI).

Her scientific work includes more than 175 publications in peer-reviewed international scientific journals, with more than 1800 citations, writing 4 Greek and 3 foreign monographs, writing 4 Greek and 3 chapters in English-language literary texts and editing 480 announcement papers in Greek and international conferences.

She has participated in scientific events as a spokesperson and coordinator at round tables and nursing conferences. She has been a member of many organizing and scientific committees of Greek and international conferences. She is also a member of the Hellenic Nurse's Association and the Hellenic Regulatory Board of Nurses.

She has participated in research programs and is a member of the editorial committee of many international and national scientific journals. She is also a paper reviewer in scientific journals and she has obtained two (2) honor rewards in International conferences.

Her scientific and research interests are in the History of Nursing and the Health Sciences in general, Basic and Community Nursing, Nursing Health Care, Ethics and Ethics of Nursing, Nursing Education and Research, School Nursing and Nursing.
