Areti Tsaloglidou is a Registered Nurse since 1997. From 2002 to 2012, she has worked as a nurse at "AHEPA" University Hospital of Thessaloniki (Intensive Care Unit and Dialysis Unit). From 2012-2016 she worked as Clinical Nurse Lecturer in the Nursing department of Alexandrion Technological Educational Institute (ATEI) of Thessaloniki. From 2016 to 2019 she worked as an Assistant Professor in the Nursing department of the Alexandrion Technological Educational Institute (ATEI) of Thessaloniki and from 2019 to July 2022 in the Nursing department of the International Hellenic University. From August 2022 until today she works as an Associate Professor in the same department of the International Hellenic University. In addition to her duties in the undergraduate curriculum, she also teaches in four postgraduate programs related to her field of expertise in the International Hellenic University and in the University of Thessaly.

She studied Nursing at the ATEI of Thessaloniki in 1997. In 2000 completed her Master's Degree in Advanced Nursing Practice at the University of Nottingham, UK and in 2001 she attended a three months postgraduate program at the "Deborah Heart and Lung Center", New Jersey, USA. In 2008, she had her PhD in "Human Performance and Health" at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Nowadays, she is a post-doctoral student at the same University.

Her scientific work includes more than 75 publications in peer-reviewed International scientific journals, with more than 620 citations. She has also more than 150 presentations at Greek and International conferences, she has written 9 chapters in English and Greek scientific books and she has translated in Greek and edited a Biology book. She has also edited the Greek version of a book on Community Nursing/Public Health Nursing.

She has participated in 6 research programs and in many scientific events as a spokeswoman and coordinator at round tables and Nursing conferences. She has been a member of many organizing and scientific committees of Greek and international conferences. She is also a member of the Hellenic Nurse's Association and the Hellenic Regulatory Board of Nurses. Furthermore, she is a paper reviewer in 5 scientific journals and she has obtained 2 honor rewards in International conferences.

Her scientific and research interests are mainly in Cardiology and Pulmonary Nursing and additionally in Perioperative Nursing, Emergency Nursing / ICU, Ethics of Nursing, Nursing History, Education and Research, School Nursing and Nursing in general.
